NAMING OPPORTUNITIES AND DONOR RECOGNITION PROGRAM

As part of the Creating a Bold Future campaign, the Food Bank of Delaware is committed to recognizing every contributor of \$250 or more who supported this important project.

Naming Opportunities: \$1,500 or more

Contributors who commit at least \$1,500 over three years are encouraged to select a prominent area or location at the Food Bank's new home as their Naming Opportunity. Contributors may choose to memorialize in perpetuity their personal participation in the fund drive or choose perhaps to honor their parents, children, or a friend.

Certain locations lend themselves to the inclusion of a contributor's actual name - The Robin R. Smith Meeting Room, for instance. Other areas such as offices are more appropriate for the prominent placement of an attractive recognition plaque (situated nearby) that acknowledges the contributor's generosity but without "naming" the selected area.
